## Author Guidelines

Authors submitting their articles must follow these guidelines:

1. Articles should have 4500-7000 words (including references and appendices).
2. The articles should be typed double-spaced on one side of A4 size paper with 1.5" margins in all sides. Two hard copies of the manuscript (text files of Microsoft Word, Times New Roman, 12 point normal) and in case of Devanagari script, it should be in 1.5 line space, typed in 14 point (Preeti font) and electronic copies of the articles along with author's bio-data are required.
3. APA 7th edition style should be followed for citation, referencing, tables and figures.
4. The author's name, affiliation and email address should be on a separate page (first page), and the title (maximum 12 words), the abstract (150 to 250 words), the keywords (4-6 words) and the article should start from the second page.



5. Tables, charts, graphs should be numbered and clearly visible in black and white.
6. If there is any acknowledgment or declaration, it should be mentioned before references. Appendices should be placed after references. Please avoid long appendices.
7. Authors will be responsible for plagiarism. Plagiarized writing from any author might result in cancelling that particular author from submitting writing in this journal later on.  
to be specific, plagiarism should be below 20%.
8. The article should be in MS word file form with at least 15 references.
9. Title should be brief, clear, concise and informative with 120 characters. The author's name and present affiliation should appear just below the title.
10. The article must be submitted through email at: milanrajurijan@gmail.com
11. The research articles must have the following format:
  - ❖ **Title** (within 12 words, specific and informative reflecting the main issue/theme)
  - ❖ **Abstract** (between 150 to 250 words with background information of the issue or problem being researched, purpose, research method and research design with research tools, major finding and the implication/conclusion)
  - ❖ **Keywords** (at least five keywords should be provided at the bottom of the abstract in alphabetical order)
  - ❖ **Introduction** (should raise the research problem/issue with concise background, state the context, problem statement with its significance or rationale of the study and the objectives/research questions/hypothesis)
  - ❖ **Literature Review/Theoretical Framework** (Optional as it may be the part of Introduction; theoretical, thematic, policy and empirical review providing a description, summary and critical evaluation of the works in relation to the research problem being investigated with the research gap.
  - ❖ **Methods and Procedures** (research method, research design, population and sample or participants, sampling strategy, research site/context, tools, and procedure of analysis and interpretation)
  - ❖ **Results** (Results should be stated concisely and clearly in descriptive, tabular and graphical forms etc. without interpretation. This section should address objectives/ specific objectives systematically)
  - ❖ **Discussion** (Why that happened? interpret and describe the significance of your findings/results with critique and arguments/ counterarguments linking with relevant theories and previous studies; A combined Results and Discussion section is often appropriate)
  - ❖ **Conclusion** ( it is not a summary: derive conclusion from the results and discussion being reflective, implication, recommendation for future research related to your topic: no references)
  - ❖ **References** (follow the APA 7<sup>th</sup> edition ,at least 15 references)
  - ❖ **Appendix** (if needed, appears after the references)
12. Only the research-based articles will be considered for peer-reviewing.
13. The submissions must be original and must not be submitted for publication nor under consideration for publication at another journal.
